wigellan – fine wine navigator – why and what for?

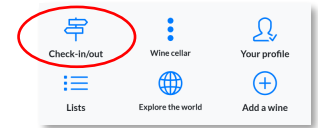
You are probably here to explore the world of wine.

- There are about 3 million different wines in production today. You can probably try around a couple of thousand wines in a lifetime, how do you make the best of it?
- Wigellan is a wine log for your journey and supports your own detailed travel plan and chart of the territories that you prefer.
- Wigellan is about finding, charting and logging:
 - The wines you drink
 - Where you drink them
 - With whom you enjoyed the wine
- Wine is also an instant journey through time and vintages, therefore wigellan also includes a cellar manager to manage your purchases and to plan consumption over time. A cellared wine is a discovered wine but still lacking your taste notes.
- Wigellan has functionality to build and share lists for recommendations, bucket, remember, producer and wine area. Aggregate your multi layered goals regarding what, when and where to enjoy wines in the future.
- Wigellan is a navigational tool to make most out of your wine journey but wigellan is not making the maps. Wigellan connects to the best wine resources providing the maps and travel guides constantly under revision.
- A logger and charter is about visualization. Wigellan is therefore committed to develop the most beautiful visualization tools to support insights for your unique wine journey over space and time.
- Wigellan is also built on bootstrap which provides responsive user interface suitable for both computer, cell phone, and/or iPad.
- **Important: Drink with care, drink less but truly and only memorable wines from the best winemakers!**
- Shall we get started with the basics?

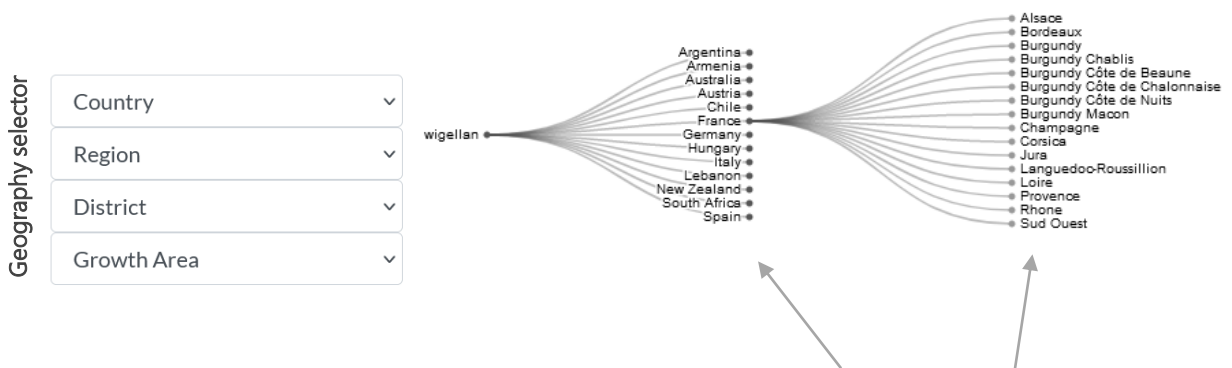


wigellan – fine wine navigator – find your first stop?

Let's go to the most important part of wigellan:



- **Check-in/out** is central with the area menu opening the world of wines. To successfully navigate the wine world, you need to pay attention to the geography of wine. Don't worry, Wigellan supports you and all navigational features are included under the hood for you to grow into.



- There are currently about 100 000 wine in wigellan divided into 53 countries, 310 regions, 1281 districts and 2805 growing areas. The wines and producers in the database are the most traded wines but far from complete. Anyhow, the database holds a majority of the world's fine wines + it's easy to add your discoveries as long as they are presented by wine-searcher.com. The database itself is issued and updated by Liv-Ex.com.
- Find your first stop – find the wine: "*Silex*" by "*Dagueneau*", two easy ways.

1. Use the **producer wine name searcher**. Note that the geography selector limits the selection. Use for example "Dag" and "Sil" with no geography selected to get a single result.

2. Browse the **Geography Selector** and go to the wine area, if you know that Silex is made in Upper Loire with 714 wines listed. Use the **list filter** to reduce the list that can be up to 6000 entries long.

- By check-in the wines into your drinking history, cellar or a list, the charting and information aggregation starts, statistics are calculated, and journey plotted. The information will become more useful over time. Everything is kept in one place.
- Easiest way to start and learn is to check in some wine to both history and cellar.

wigellan – fine wine navigator – cellar



- The cellar functionality is simple and straight forward

The wines are arranged per "Drink year". It's easy to filter a view of your cellar according to for example food pairing. Maybe you want to see only red wines or Italian, Barolo wines only. When you check out a bottle from the cellar, it's automatically transferred to your history.

- Geography including total number of bottles

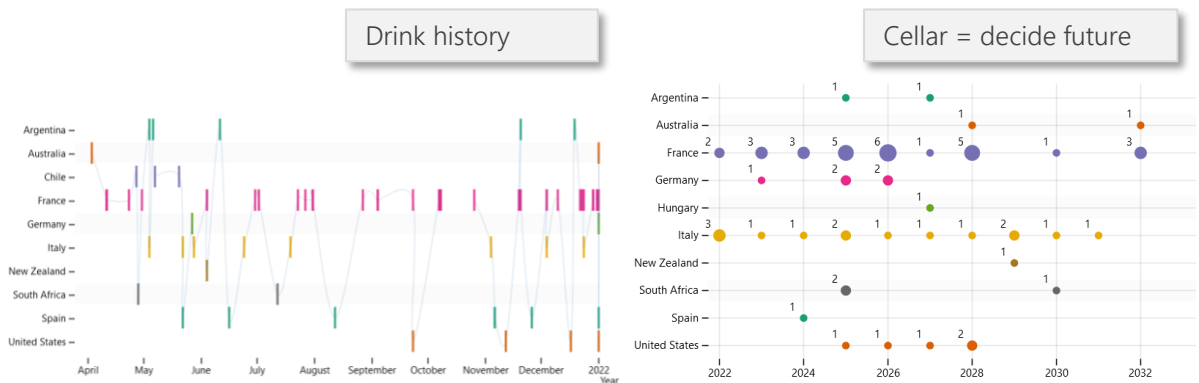

• The User profile

Congratulations, now you are charting and plotting. Some things to understand before we are fully navigating.

- The user profile page provides a summary of consumption and cellar with some visuals that start to show your data when you have entered 10 entries. This is all for reflection:
 - Does my cellar hold the right quantity of bottles?
 - Do I consume and cellar wines according to my preferences?
 - Are the right wine areas represented?
 - Compared to the number of wines enjoyed, do I have ample wine areas and/or producers?



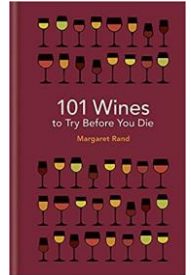
- Navigation is setting a course for discovery, not to travel randomly. It's about carefully charting the discoveries and evaluating the next step. Hopefully wigellan can be your navigational tool to make the best of the trip.
- We are all having our individual travel budget, please click [Edit profile](#) to let wigellan know your budget in order to optimize what lists will be presented to you. This functionality is not all in place for the moment, but this is also a way to reflect about the journey. Anyhow we believe that the wigellan user spends at least 15-20€ and up per bottle or is an expert to identify very priceworthy quality producers.
- Also set your alias by clicking [Edit info](#). The alias is required to create a list, which could be a simple remember list to fill in the wines you are recommended by friends.
- The set alias is also the only thing that will ever be shared. All traveling goes incognito and wigellan will never share your information with other parties. Your data will always be kept secret within wigellan.
- With this reflection, it's time to go over the list functionality. The lists are there to both inspire but also create crumb trails for others to follow.

• Lists – 3 basic types of journeys

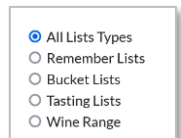
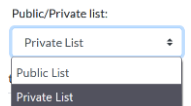
1. **Wine list**, a collection of wines from different/same producers. These list has always been around as "*Winespectator top100*" list published annually or in books like "*101 Wines to try before..*". This feature exists in many other apps but are in wigellan more integrated with other functionality.
2. **Producer list**, is a list of producers including indirectly all wines from each producer. These lists are not so common but very useful for describing a path or goal for a journey. A top winemaker often release good quality wines only. To point out a distinguished winemaker is more versatile than just listing one of her/his wines. A good example of this is the "*Top10 German winemaker list*" which is a wonderful and price efficient journey to go for.
3. **Area lists** are more abstract but provide endless variations for wine journeys. Just think about the journey of drinking a wine from each 1cru area in Bourgogne or the present "*Islands of wine*" comprising 8 island wine areas from 6 countries and very accessible wines. My personal favorite "*Clive Coates 3 star Burgundy Red Area*" list that has the maybe 14 best wine plots on this planet.



• Lists – usage and authors intent

Note that each list has a setting **Public/Private** list. You choose if to publish a list or keep it strictly private!

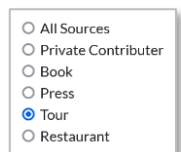
1. **Remember lists** are just as it sounds. It could be wines/producers/areas you want to keep in mind or simply a shopping list.
2. **Bucket lists** is a list that offers a journey and a destination to reach. More bucket lists will be added from authors that maybe share your interest and can plot a journey according to your taste and experience level. You can hopefully both publish and create/provide further lists/journeys for other wine lovers.
3. **Tasting lists** are typically what you provide when you are arranging a wine tasting. Share the list with the participants for easy logging.
4. **Wine range** is a list type for restaurants and bars to promote parts of their offering. In the long run, maybe full wine lists can be published.



• Lists – source – give credits

Inspiration to make lists comes in many forms and should be quoted and get credit. Don't undermine the business of the source in the way you are publishing your list. To point out and list some of the wines in for example in a wine article raises the interest for the source. If you are hesitant, ask the author for permission. It's a small world so let the good karma flow.

1. **Private contributor**, typically you or a friend that you want to quote.
2. **Book** that inspired you. In "100 wines before .." wigellan listed half of the wines and provided a link to amazon, hopefully boosting sales of the book.
3. **Press**, you list what you think are the most exciting wines in a magazine or newspaper article. Example: "*Decanter Wines of the year 2021*".
4. **Tour**, when you participated in a wine tour and assembled a wigellan list to describe it. Look for example at "*Alsace Top 5 Tour Producer Guide*".
5. **Restaurant** when your inspiration comes from a wine package or parts of the restaurants wine cellar that you want to emphasize.



Let's go over to the Lists user interface!

• Lists – usage

The goal is to have thousands of interesting lists on wigellan for selection and to be marked as part of your wine journey providing guidance. You see your own lists and other users' public lists. There is a simple free text search and three sets of checkboxes to reduce selection. Just click a list and you see the content, for example *"Welcome to wigellan list"*.

Welcome to wigellan list

The Update Info and Delete list is not active if you are not the owner of the list. Note to the right, that the wine modal has a button "Add to List". This is the best way to transfer a listed wine to one of your lists. Create the list and go over to "Check i/o" page to browse the wines you want to add + use the "Add to List" button on the wine modal. Start to make some wine lists before producer lists. Try the area lists last. Area list are very powerful but a little bit abstract at first.

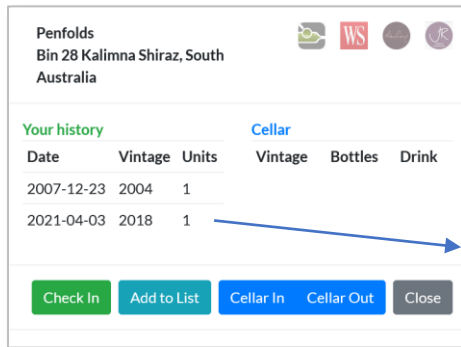
The list functionality is novel and will be further developed in order to create a tangible wine travel vision that will guide you to the places you really want to go.

• Wine management and error correction

Part of charting wines into history and cellar is also making insert errors. Wrong vintage, price or maybe the wine. How do I correct errors in wigellan? The functionality is again in the wine modal. For example, the Bin28 drank 2021-04-03 was maybe vintage 2017 and not 2018. To correct values, just click the entry that you want to correct.



Note the text, “-This is an independent entry”. This means that there are no other entries related to this entry and it can be easily edited. But complexity increase if the entry was a part of a purchase 1 of 4 bottles with still 3 in the cellar. Any updates will affect all bottles. Wigellan will support you. Some mistakes are easiest corrected by deleting the entry and start all over.

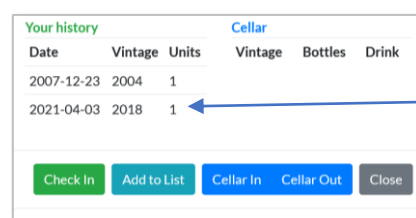
The cellar correction modal looks different and provides some extra options as:

1. Update drink year and or storage.
2. Split a cellar entry to another drink year or storage.
3. Correct the entry as for history described up right.
